

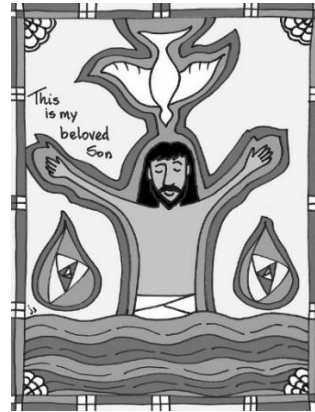
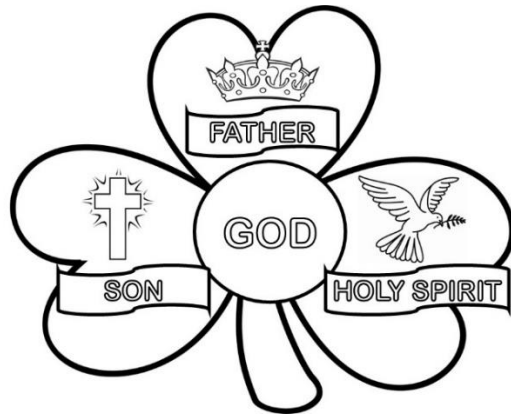
THE HOLY TRINITY

GOD is Three Persons in One: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

How can we understand this? One example is to look at a three-leaf clover. A clover has three leaves, yet each leaf is part of the same clover!

What does the Trinity teach us about God? It teaches us that God is a personal and relational God! All three Persons of the Godhead (Father, Son, and Holy Spirit) are in a family relationship with each other. They are One with each other and together are God who is One.

God also wants us to be in a family relationship with Him. He wants us to be one with Him and with other followers of Jesus in God's family.

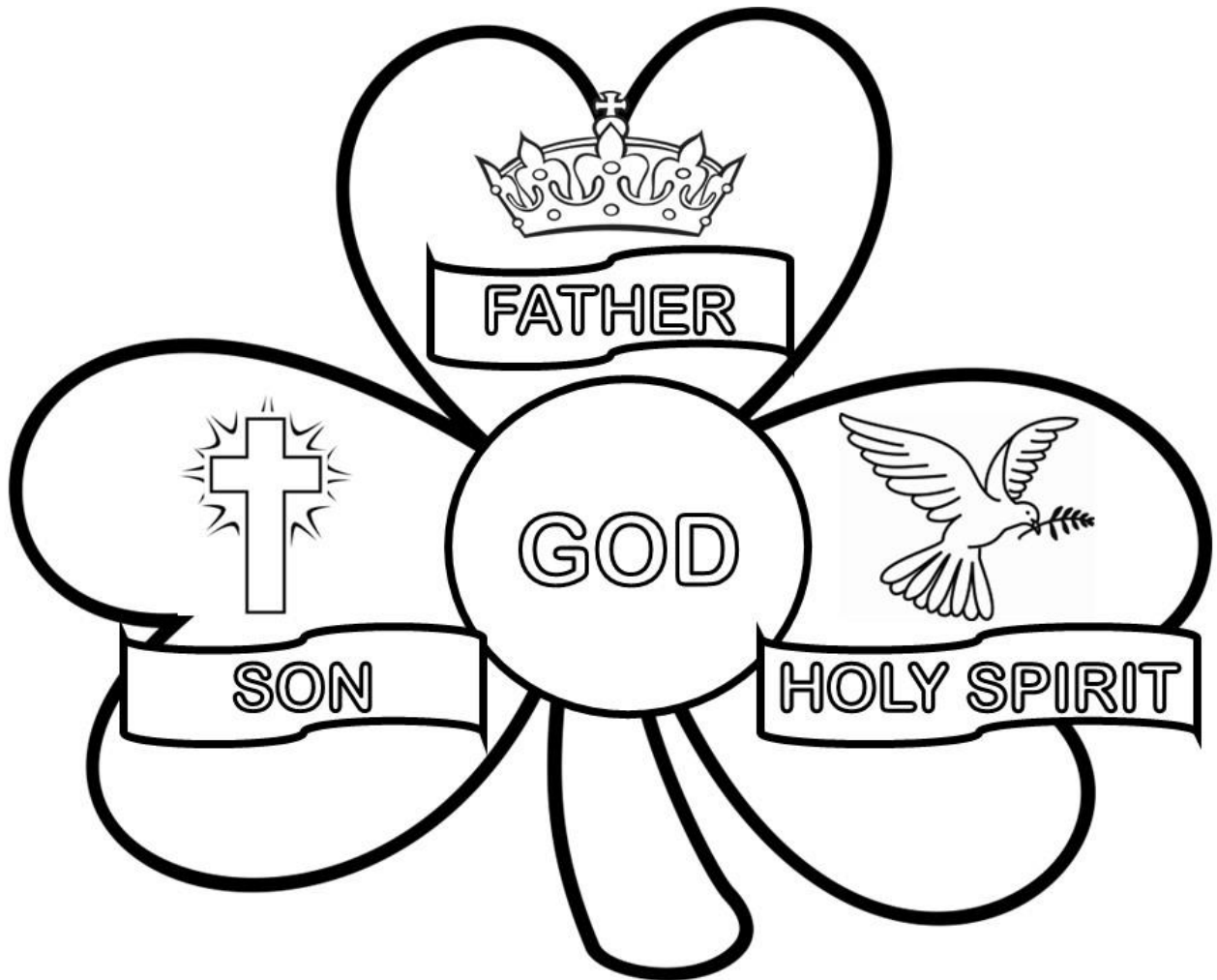
- Read Matthew 3:16-17: How do we see each of the 3 Persons of God's Holy Trinity in action in this verse? _____

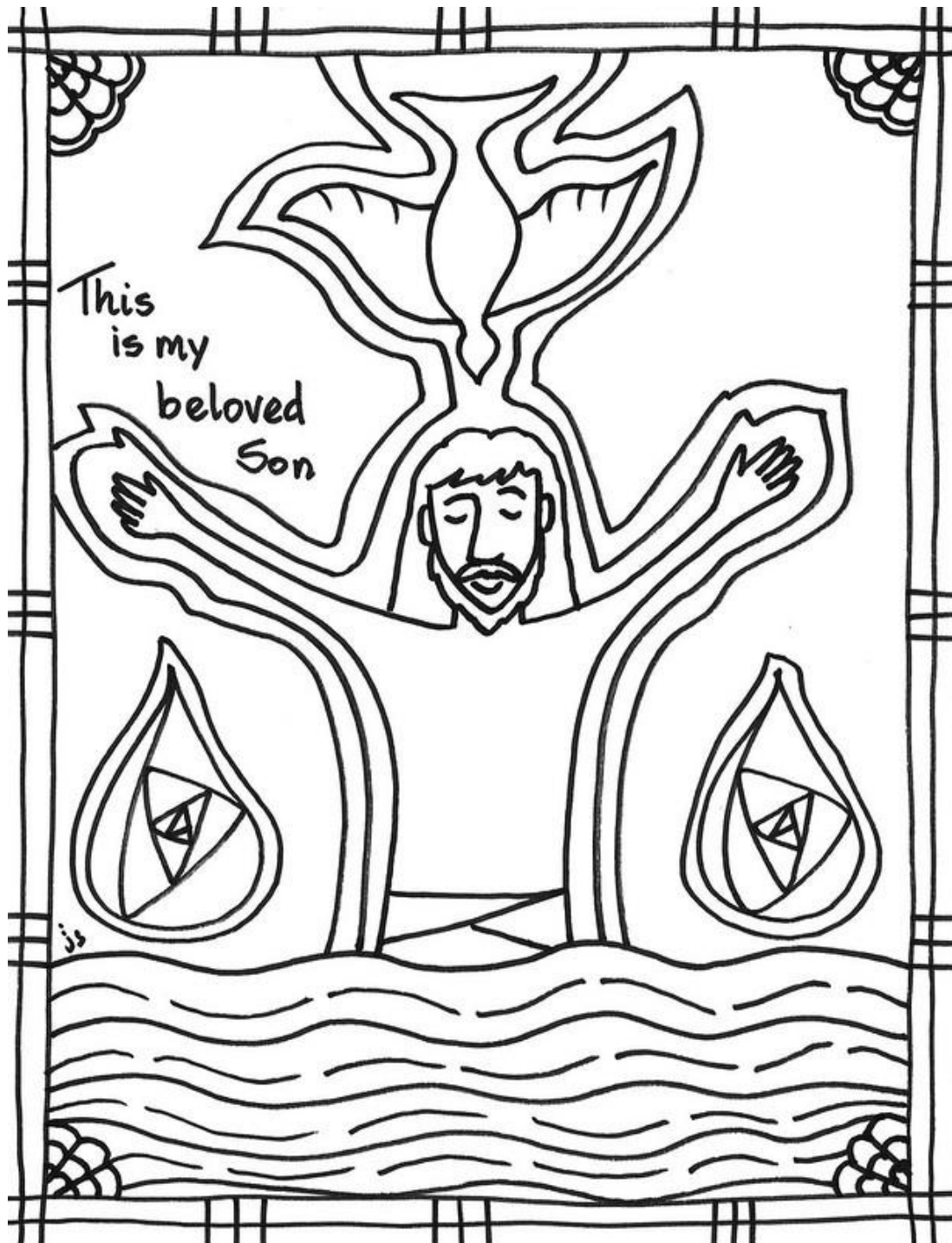
