

# Lesson: Salvation is a Gift from God!

Read the verses below and answer the questions.

## Read Ephesians 2:8-9 NLT

*"(8) God saved you by his grace when you believed. And you can't take credit for this; it is a gift from God. (9) Salvation is not a reward for the good things we have done, so none of us can boast about it."*

- 1.) According to verse 8, how does it say that God saves us? Can we take credit for it?
- 2.) According to verse 9, can we earn our own salvation through the good things we have done?

## Read Romans 3:23-25 NLT

*"(23) For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard. (24) Yet God, in his grace, freely makes us right in his sight. He did this through Christ Jesus when he freed us from the penalty for our sins. (25) For God presented Jesus as the sacrifice for sin. People are made right with God when they believe that Jesus sacrificed his life, shedding his blood."*

- 1.) According to verse 23, is there anyone who has not sinned? Who has sinned?
- 2.) According to verses 24-25, how does God make us right with Himself?

## Read John 3:16 NIV

*"(16) For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life."*

- 1.) According to this verse, why did God give us His Son, Jesus?
- 2.) According to this verse, what happens when we believe in Jesus, God's one and only Son?
- 3.) According to this verse, who gets to receive this gift of eternal life?

## Read Romans 10:9-10 NIRV

*"9 Say with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord." Believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead. Then you will be saved. 10 With your heart you believe and are made right with God. With your mouth you say what you believe. And so you are saved."*

- According to this verse, what must we do to be saved?

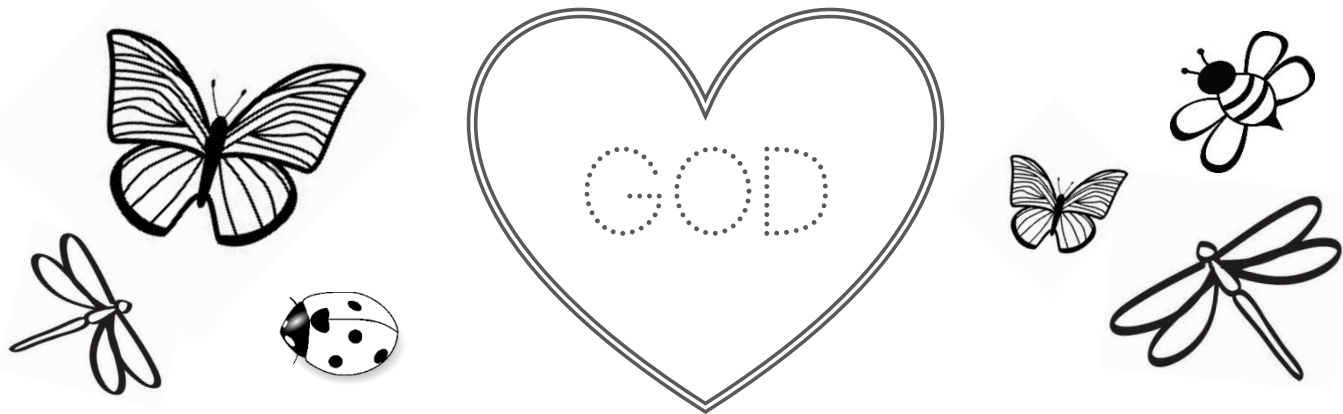

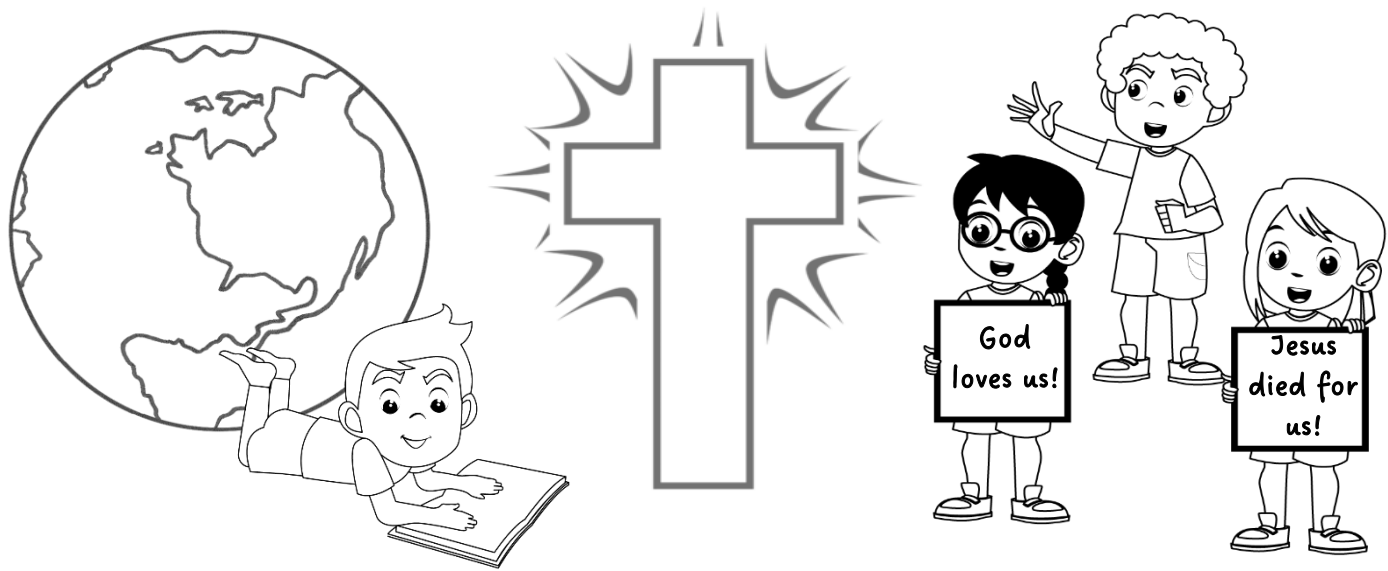

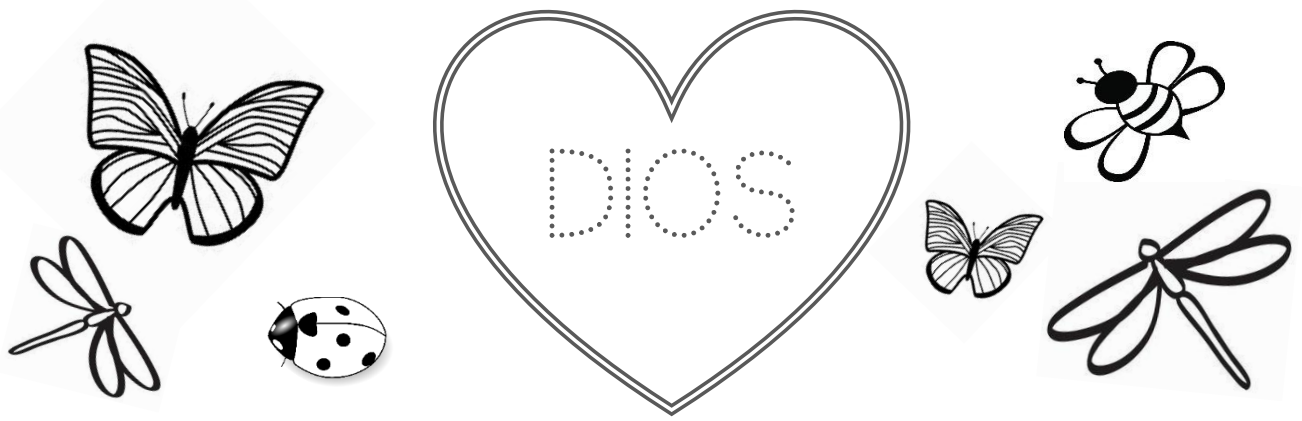
