





Palm Sunday marks the beginning of Holy Week. It is a celebration of Jesus' entry into Jerusalem where he was met by crowds of people waving palm branches and shouting 'Hosanna'

Mark 11:1-11 and Luke 18:28-40



HOLY MONDAY

Jesus wept over Jerusalem and cleansed the temple for the 2nd time in his ministry. Why did he clean the temple? Jesus wanted the temple to be a place where all nations could come to worship. With the temple set up as a market, those who looked to worship, could not. Jesus still wants all nations to have access to the gospel message of hope.

Mark 11:22 and Luke 19:41-48



HOLY TUESDAY

Jesus taught in the temple for the last time as a free man. His words were a final public declaration establishing his authority and desire to seek and save lost people. The leaders of the day did not receive his words well.

Mark 11:27-14:2 and Luke 20:1-22:2



HOLY WEDNESDAY

Jesus rested. While resting, a woman poured expensive oil on his head. While the disciples criticized the woman, Jesus honored that she had done what she could. Jesus is still asking us to do what we can. Judas and the Sanhedrin prepare to arrest Jesus.

Mark 14:3-11 and Luke 22:3-6





MAUNDY THURSDAY

Jesus began the Lord's supper, washed the disciple's feet, went to the Garden of Gethsemane to pray, was betrayed by Judas and Peter denied him 3 times. Jesus knew what was coming and willingly walked toward death so that you might know eternal life.

Luke 22:7-71 and John 13:1-18:27



GOOD FRIDAY

Jesus was handed over to Pilate and his death sentence was delivered. Jesus was beaten and hung on a cross to die. On the cross, Jesus was forsaken by God, taking on the sins of the world. He was forsaken so you would never have to be. By the end of Good Friday, Jesus body was taken down and laid in the tomb.

Matthew 27:1-61 and Luke 23:1-56



Perhaps the darkest day in history, on Holy Saturday Jesus' body lay buried. A guard was placed at his tomb. Those who killed him probably rejoiced. Those who loved him mourned. In the silence of Saturday though, God was still working.
