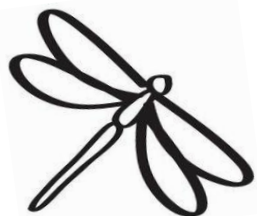
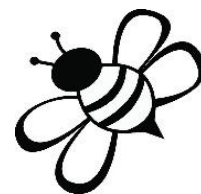


Read 1 Corinthians 13, then answer the following questions.

Love is...

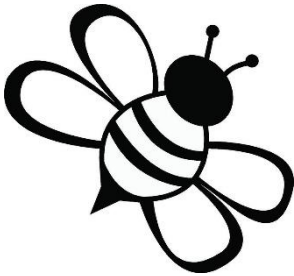


Love is patient.

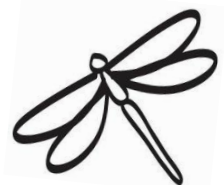
