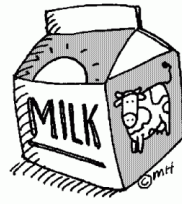
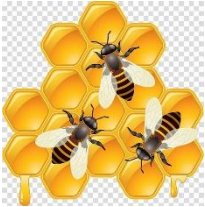




Jesus answered, "It is written, 'Man must not live only on bread. He must also live on every word that comes from the mouth of God.'" - Matthew 4:4 NIRV

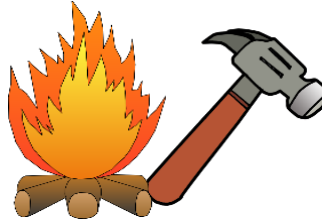
How sweet are your words to my taste, sweeter than honey to my mouth! -Psalm 119:103 NIV

"Is not my word like fire," declares the LORD, "and like a hammer that breaks a rock in pieces?" -Jeremiah 23:29 NIV



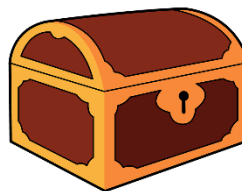
Take the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. -Ephesians 6:17 NLT



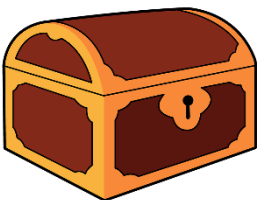

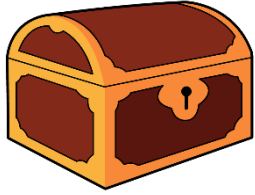


Wherever your treasure is, there the desires of your heart will also be. -Matthew 6:21 NLT
